In many cases the behaviour can be down to them seeing the reaction of others, lack of differentiation within the class, an undiagnosed special education need or maybe things which are going on outside of the school environment. Nisai's short-term courses are used for student re-engagement, covering gaps in a part-time timetable and also periods of fixed-term exclusion.
